#### **Next Generation Manufacturing Investment Programme**

Funding of \$30 million is available to help eligible businesses with capital projects to establish or expand their high value manufacturing capabilities in South Australia or Victoria. Businesses can now apply for grants ranging from \$500,000 to \$2.5 million. Successful businesses will also invest their own funds into their projects, with the grants contributing up to a third of eligible project costs. The grants will support business investment in manufacturing operations driven by technological innovation, advanced processes and a highly skilled workforce.
